2. Scholarship and Bursary Students

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The deposit will be forfeited if a student withdraws from residence during the first year.

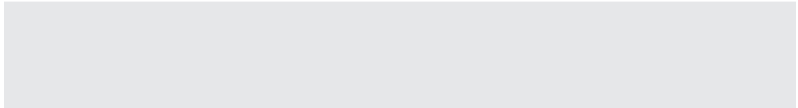
Students living in a dormitory are encouraged to add a late fee of \$300 to their residence deposit at the end of the first year.

Rent and utilities will be billed by the first day of the month and will be billed in advance.

3. Other Charges

- **Damage deposit:** A deposit of \$250 is required of new students upon first coming to residence. This deposit is for the care of the room and the use of the room. The deposit is not refundable. Damage to the room or the room's contents will be deducted from the deposit. The deposit will be refunded, in full, at the end of the first year if the student remains in residence. Damage to the room or the room's contents of \$250 will be billed in advance.
- **Laundry fee:** \$65
- **Key replacement:** \$25 per key
- **House dues (in support of the activities of the house committee):** \$50 all houses. \$25 for dormitory and \$25 for residence.
