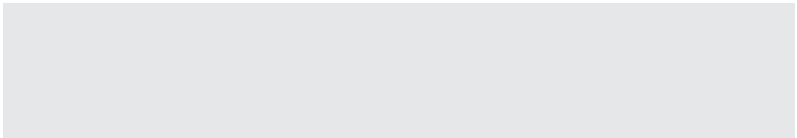


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A. Bachelor of Ar Degree

Honours Program

The Honours Program is designed to provide students with a rigorous and challenging academic experience. It is a two-year program that leads to a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree with Honours.

c. General Curriculum Requirements

The Honours Program requires students to complete a minimum of 120 credit hours, including 60 credit hours of Honours-level coursework. Students must also complete a thesis or dissertation as part of the program.

d. Grade Point Average Required for Honours

Students must maintain a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 throughout the Honours program. Additionally, students must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 in all Honours-level coursework. The Honours program is a two-year program, and students must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours of Honours-level coursework, including a thesis or dissertation.

e. Procedures for Withdrawal from Honours

Students who wish to withdraw from the Honours program must do so in writing to the Honours Program Director. Withdrawal from the program will result in the student being required to complete the remaining requirements for the BA degree.

f. Minor (optional)

Students may also choose to complete a minor in a related field. The minor program is optional and requires a minimum of 18 credit hours. The minor program is designed to provide students with a more specialized and in-depth understanding of a particular area of study.
